

VITALITY U19 CLUB T20 – TICKETS COMPETITION (2018 SEASON)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Competition Overview

1. England and Wales Cricket Board Limited ("**ECB**") a company registered in England and Wales with its registered office at Lord's Cricket Ground, St Johns Wood, London, NW8 8QZ is operating a free prize draw (the "**Competition**") to win one of two sets of 15 tickets to either a One-Day or T20 International match held in England and Wales during the 2018 season (each a "**Match**") (to be determined by the ECB in their sole discretion).
2. Entrants are deemed to have accepted, and agree to be bound by, these terms and conditions upon entry into the Competition.
3. The ECB reserves the right to cancel the Competition or to amend these terms and conditions at any time without notice. Notification of cancellation or any amendment(s) will be posted on the ECB website.
4. The decision of the ECB regarding any aspect of the Competition is final and binding (including as to the award of the Prizes), and the ECB shall not enter into any correspondence regarding the Competition.

Entry Process

5. The Competition will be open for entry between 9am (GMT) on Tuesday 20 March 2018 and close at midnight (GMT) on Monday 9th April. Entries received after this time will not be valid and will not be included in the Competition prize draw.
6. To enter the Competition, an Entrant must register their amateur cricket club ("**Club**") by completing the prescribed online application form for the Vitality U19 Club T20 2018 tournament (the "**Tournament**"). Entries will not be accepted by any other means. The Competition is free to enter and only one entry per Entrant is permitted.
7. Upon completing the prescribed application form, each individual registering their team will be automatically entered into the Competition (unless such individual has opted out on the application form).
8. In order to be eligible to enter to the Competition, all Entrants must be aged 18 or over and must be resident in the United Kingdom. Employees of the ECB, their immediate families and any individual directly or indirectly associated with the operation of the Competition shall not be eligible to enter the Competition.
9. In entering the Competition, each Entrant confirms that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize (defined below). The ECB may require an Entrant to provide proof that they are eligible to enter the Competition (including proof of age).
10. The ECB accepts no responsibility for Competition entries that not successfully completed, regardless of cause, including (without limitation) due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, of any kind.

Prize

11. The ECB will select two separate winners of the Competition at random, each of which shall win one set of 15 tickets to a Match ("**Prize**"). The Entrant agrees that the Prize must be distributed to players at their Club (and their parents/guardians if required) and to no other third party, in compliance with any directions from the ECB from time to time. For the avoidance of doubt, the Prize shall not include any expenses incurred by any

winning Entrant or any other person in connection with claiming or enjoying the Prize (including but not limited to travel and accommodation expenses).

12. The winning Entrant will be contacted on or around Friday 13th April 2018 using the email address provided upon entry into the Competition and will be sent the Prize via email or post.
13. The winning entrant must confirm that they are able to accept the Prize on or before 5pm (GMT) on Monday 23rd May 2018. In the event that any winning Entrant fails to confirm their acceptance of the Prize by this date (or the ECB otherwise determines that the relevant winner has breached these terms and conditions), the ECB reserves the right to offer the Prize to another Entrant.
14. The ECB reserves the right to substitute or withdraw the Prize at any time in its complete discretion. The Prize for the winner is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The Prize must not be resold.

Limitation of Liability

15. The ECB nor any of their affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Competition or as a result of any Entrant's participation in the Competition or as a result of the winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of any Prize by any person, or if the Competition does not run as planned. Competition Entrants' statutory rights are not affected.
16. The ECB reserves the right to otherwise cancel the Competition or to amend these terms and conditions or the Prize at any time without notice and no liability shall attach to the ECB as a result thereof.

Entrants' Personal Data

17. The ECB and its affiliates will use the data you provide in response to the Competition ("**Your Information**") for the purposes of operating the Competition. This may include sharing such personal data with third party suppliers solely for the purpose of those third parties delivering the Prize or otherwise in connection with the operation of the Competition.
18. Each prize winner hereby acknowledges and agrees that, by entering the Competition, the ECB may publish their name and nationality, as well as their town/city of residence and name of their amateur cricket club on the ECB's website or other format as deemed appropriate by the ECB (subject always to the ECB's obligations under applicable data protection laws).
19. The winning Entrants may be asked to take part in and certain promotional activities of the ECB relating to the Competition.

General

20. If any of these terms are determined to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable then Entrants agree that the remaining terms shall continue in full force and effect.
21. The ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to the Competition, or refuse to award the Prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions or to anyone, who in ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
22. These terms and conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales and the parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.
