| Your right to withdraw consent | Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it. |
| Direct marketing | <p>We hope you would like to hear from us and others involved in cricket and that you will allow us to use your personal data for direct marketing and to tailor our marketing communications to suit what we think you will find interesting and relevant (profiling).</p> <p>You can choose the information you receive by selecting your preferences on sign up. You can change your mind at any time.</p> |
| Location of your personal data | The ECB will normally keep your personal data within the European Economic Area. However, the ECB's service provider will process relevant data in the USA with any personal data being protected under the EU-US privacy shield or other EU approved arrangements. |
| How long we will keep your personal data for | We will normally keep your personal data for 2 years. After this time period we will anonymise your information and keep for analysis of engagement trends. |
| Your rights in respect of your personal data | You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability. |
