

## Cricket World Cup Club / Professional Cricketers Association event 2019

### Terms and Conditions

#### Competition Overview

1. England and Wales Cricket Board Limited (“**ECB**”), a company registered in England and Wales with its registered office at Lord’s Cricket Ground, St John’s Wood, London, NW8 8QZ, is operating an open competition (the “**Competition**”) in which individual members (the “**Entrants**”, each an “**Entrant**”) of ECB affiliated cricket clubs (each a “**Club**”) will be able to provide information on why their club should be chosen as the host venue for a visit from the Professional Cricketers Association (“**PCA**”) England Masters cricket team (the “**Information**”) to play a free one-off game against the Entrant’s Club (the “**Prize**”).
2. Each Entrant who validly enters this competition in accordance with these terms and conditions is deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by, these terms and conditions upon entry into the Competition.
3. The decision of the ECB regarding any aspect of the Competition is final and binding (including as to the award of the Prize), and the ECB shall not enter into any correspondence regarding the Competition.

#### Entry Process

4. The Competition will be open for entry between 00:01am on 4 February 2019 and close at midnight on 1 March 2019. Entries received after this time will not be valid and will not be included in the Competition prize draw.
5. In order to be eligible to enter the Competition, Entrants must be 18 years old or over and must be a member of a Club. Employees of the ECB, their immediate families and any individual directly or indirectly associated with the operation of the Competition shall not be eligible to enter the Competition.
6. In entering the Competition, each Entrant confirms that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize. The ECB may require an Entrant to provide proof that they are eligible to enter the Competition (including proof of age).
7. To enter the Competition, Entrants must use the Cricket World Cup Club entry system (the “**System**”) to submit the Information. Entries will not be accepted by any other means.
8. The Competition is free to enter and no purchase is necessary. Only one entry per Club is permitted.

9. The ECB accepts no responsibility for Competition entries that are not successfully completed, regardless of cause, including (without limitation) due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, of any kind.

#### **Prize**

10. The Competition will be adjudicated by a panel of ECB and PCA staff (the “**Panel**”) and the winner of the Competition will be decided by the Panel based solely on the Information submitted in to the System.
11. If it is decided a number of entries cannot be separated based on the Information submitted by the respective Entrants, a random prize draw, in which Entrant names will be randomly selected from a hat, will take place for those entries only.
12. The winning Entrant will be contacted on or around 4 March 2019 using the email address that was used to submit the Entrant’s unique Information into the System.
13. Each Entrant hereby agrees that, if he or she is a prize winner, his or her name, town/city of residence and the name of his or her Club may be published on the ECB’s Website.
14. The winning Entrant must confirm that his or her Club is able to accept the Prize within 10 days of notification that they have won the Competition. In the event that the winning Entrant fails to confirm that his or her Club is able to accept the Prize within this timeframe (or the ECB otherwise determines that the relevant winner has breached these terms and conditions), the ECB reserves the right to offer the Prize to another Entrant.
15. The ECB reserves the right to substitute Competition prizes at any time with prizes of equal or greater value. The Prize for the winning Entrant is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The Prize must not be resold.
16. The Prize will be awarded to the Entrant for the benefit of his or her Club and each Entrant agrees not to accept a prize for their personal use or that of any person other than his or her Club and the Entrant agrees to the ECB monitoring the impact and use by his or her Club of any prize won.

#### **Limitation of Liability**

17. Neither the ECB nor any of their affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Competition or as a result of any Entrant’s participation in the Competition or as a result of the winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of any Prize, or if the Competition does not run as planned. Competition Entrants’ statutory rights are not affected.

18. The ECB reserves the right to otherwise cancel the Competition or to amend these terms and conditions or the Prize at any time without notice and no liability shall attach to the ECB as a result thereof.

#### **Entrants' Personal Data**

19. The ECB and its affiliates will use the data you provide in response to the Competition ("**Your Information**") for the purposes of operating the Competition. Your Information will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation and will only be processed in accordance with the ECB privacy policy (available at <https://www.ecb.co.uk/privacy>) (the "**ECB Privacy Policy**") and these terms and conditions. This may include sharing such personal data with third party suppliers solely for the purpose of those third parties delivering the Prize or otherwise in connection with the operation of the Competition.
20. The winning Entrants may be asked to take part in certain promotional activities of the ECB relating to the Competition and the ECB reserves the right to use the names and images of Entrants for its promotional purposes provided that the consent of the Entrant has been obtained in advance.

#### **General**

21. If any of these terms are determined to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable then Entrants agree that the remaining terms shall continue in full force and effect.
22. The ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to the Competition, or refuse to award the Prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions or to anyone, who in the ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
23. These terms and conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales and the parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.
