ICC MEN'S CRICKET WORLD CUP 2019, TROPHY CARRIER

PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Competition Overview

1. England and Wales Cricket Board Limited (company number 03251364) whose registered office is at Lords Cricket Ground, St Johns Wood, London, NW8 8QZ ("**ECB**") is operating a prize draw for participants of "*All Stars Cricket*" to win the opportunity to be a 'Trophy Carrier' at the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2019 at one of; New Zealand vs. Sri Lanka (Cardiff, 1st June 2019), Afghanistan vs. Australia (Bristol, 1st June 2019), South Africa vs. Bangladesh (the Oval, 2nd June 2019). The selected winner will walk the CWC Trophy out to the pitch before the start of the match and be offered two additional tickets to bring parents and/or guardians (the "**Competition**").
2. Competition entrants ("**Entrants**") are deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by, these terms and conditions upon entry into the Competition.
3. The decision of the ECB regarding any aspect of the Competition is final and binding (including as to the award of the prizes) and no correspondence will be entered into regarding any such decision.

Entry Process

4. The Competition will be open for entry between 10:00 am 1 March 2019 and 11.59pm 31 March 2019. Entries received after this time will not be valid and will not be included in the Competition prize draw.
5. The Competition is open to all All Stars Cricket participants who have registered for an All Stars Cricket programme in 2019 before midnight on Sunday 31 March 2019. Employees of the ECB are not eligible to enter the Competition.
6. To enter the Competition, Entrants must sign up to a 2019 All Stars Cricket programme and be between the ages of four and nine. Entries will not be accepted by any other means. There may be multiple entries but these email addresses must be linked to different participants.
7. The Competition is linked to an All Stars Cricket 2019 bookings and although there is no cost for the competition, the participant will be expected to pay in full for the All Stars Cricket programme.
8. In entering the Competition, each Entrant confirms that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize that they may win. The ECB may require an Entrant to provide proof that they are eligible to enter the Competition (including proof of age of their child and proof of their 2019 All Stars Cricket booking).

Prize

9. The Competition prizes include the chance to win one of three trophy carrier prizes as outlined in the competition overview:

If you are an All Stars Cricket 2019 participant:

- (a) The opportunity for an ASC participant to walk the trophy out onto the field of play before the start of the match.
- (b) Two tickets for parents/guardians to attend the match with the selected ASC participant following the 'trophy presentation'. The category of these tickets is at the discretion of the tournament organisers

(each a "**Prize**" and together the "**Prizes**").

10. Each winning Entrant will be contacted (as soon as reasonably practicable after the completion of the Competition prize draw) using the email address provided on entry into the Competition.
11. Each winning Entrant must confirm that they are able to accept the prize within 48 hours of being notified by the ECB that they are a winning Entrant. In the event that any winning Entrant fails to confirm their acceptance of the prize by this date, or is unable to accept the prize that they have won for any reason or the ECB determines that the relevant winner has breached these terms and conditions, the ECB reserves the right to offer the prize to another Entrant. The ECB does not accept any responsibility for failure by any winner(s) to claim their prize.
12. The winning Entrant will be allocated the match that they are geographically closest to out of the following matches; New Zealand vs. Sri Lanka (Cardiff, 1st June 2019), Afghanistan vs. Australia (Bristol, 1st June 2019), South Africa vs. Bangladesh (the Oval, 2nd June 2019). Confirmation of the selected match must be completed by the Entrant within 48 hours of being notified by the ECB that they are the winning Entrant (as per point 11)
13. Each Prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The Prizes do not include anything not expressly set out in these terms and conditions including spending money, food and drink, associated travel and accommodation, medical or other general expenses.
14. The ECB reserves the right to substitute each/any winner's prize for an alternative prize if necessary (in the ECB's sole discretion).

Limitation of Liability

15. Neither the ECB nor any of its partners, affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the fullest extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Competition or as a result of any Entrant's participation in the Competition or as a result of winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of any prize, if the Competition does not run as planned or if any part of any prize is unable to be delivered for any reason Entrants' statutory rights are not affected.
16. If the Competition or any part of it is not capable of running or being completed as planned for any reason, including but not limited to reasons of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of ECB, ECB reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition without liability.
17. The ECB may change these terms and conditions at any time at its discretion.

Entrants' Personal Data

18. Each Entrant consents to the personal data they supply about themselves during their entry to the Competition being used by the ECB for the purposes of operating the Competition and administering the delivery of Prizes. The ECB shall use such personal data in accordance with its updated Privacy Policy, which Entrants are deemed to accept by entering the Competition.
19. Each winning Entrant may be required to participate in publicity related to the Competition and ECB reserves the right to use the name, image, and town and county of residence of each winning Entrant in any media for such promotional purposes. The ECB may also sub-licence such right to its sponsors, partners and other relevant third parties on the same basis. The winners also agree that ECB may use their name, image and town or county of residence to announce the winner of the Competition.

General

- 21.** The ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to the Competition, to disqualify from the Competition, or to refuse to award the prize to anyone who it reasonably considers has breached these terms and conditions or to anyone, who in ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
- 22.** The Competition will be governed by English law and all Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts in relation to any disputes relating to the Competition.
- 23.** Through entering the competition, the entrants accept that they may be captured on television as part of the global broadcast of the Cricket World Cup
