CITY OF TOYOTA STADIUM



GETTING TO TOYOTA CITY

The stadium is located in Toyota City, Aichi Prefecture. It is about 310 km west of Tokyo. The nearest Shinkansen station to the stadium is Nagoya Station. Chubu International Airport is the nearest to the stadium. We have prepared the following advice to help you plan your travel. The hints and tips below should be read in conjunction with the information on each travel option that follows.

Plan and book ahead: Arrange your [travel](#) and [accommodation](#) as soon as possible. If you are an international visitor and intend travelling by train, we strongly recommend you purchase a [Japan Rail Pass](#) before you arrive.

Travel the right way: Roads are expected to be busy on match days so please use public transport, park and ride, walk or cycle where possible. Remember there is no parking at the venue except for wheelchair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space. There are also no drop-off or pick-up facilities near the venue except for taxis. If you intended driving, please use park and ride and note it is reservation only.

Travelling from within the local area: If you intend on travelling by car, park and ride could be a good option as train services are expected to be busy, particularly after the match. It is reservation only and spaces are limited so [book](#) your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.

Travelling from further away: If you are travelling longer distances by train to Toyota, consider heading to Nagoya Station and connect to services which stop at Toyota City and Shin-Toyota stations, close to the stadium. These two stations are expected to be particularly busy after the match. If you are an international visitor or travelling from elsewhere in Japan and intend

travelling by train, consider staying locally if you can and travel back the following day. You could also consider flying into Chubu International Airport and continue your journey to the stadium via public transport.

Arrive early: Arrive into Toyota with enough time to soak up the atmosphere. Don't leave it too late to get to the stadium. Gates open two and a half hours before kick-off. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat. There will be plenty to see and do inside so leave enough time to enjoy it, before the match starts.

Stay longer and enjoy the local area: Rather than travel away from the host city after the match, spend time some time at the stadium (gates close 90 minutes after the final whistle) or enjoying the local area highlights before heading to your next destination. Staying on will also help you avoid the anticipated crowds at transport hubs.

Pre-paid travel cards are best: Paying for public transport is easier using a [prepaid travel card](#) or IC Card.

Pick-up travel tickets in advance: Consider picking up your travel card or other travel tickets before match-day to avoid queues at ticket machines on the day.

Head to a Fanzone: If you're in the area early on the day of the match why not visit the Fanzone at Sky Hall, Toyota? Please check our [Fanzone](#) page for additional information

TOP TIPS



We recommend you **arrive 90 minutes early**, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat



There will be **plenty of food, drink and entertainment** on offer in the stadium that you can enjoy. Make sure you experience the unique festival atmosphere of Rugby World Cup 2019™



Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets will be accepted, and readmission is strictly prohibited



Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card



The **following items are prohibited** from being brought into match venues: Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers etc)



It is **prohibited by law to fly drones** in and around Rugby World Cup 2019™ venues and Fanzones



Please take your rubbish with you or dispose of it at the facilities provided inside the stadium



Please note that there will be **no place to leave luggage** either inside or outside venues

GETTING TO THE STADIUM

Which travel option is best?

Find out more about each travel option here.



Air

The nearest airport to the stadium is **Chubu International Airport**.

The stadium is easily accessible by public transport from the airport. Plan your journey [here](#).



Train

The nearest stations to the stadium are **Toyota Shi Station** and **Shin-Toyota Station**.

Toyota City Station is a 15-minute walk from the stadium.

Shin-Toyota Station is a 17-minute walk from the stadium.

Nagoya Station, the main station in the region, is a short train ride from both Toyota City Station and Shin-Toyota Station.





Bus

A number of spectator shuttle buses will run on the day of the match:

- An accessible shuttle bus will run between Shin-Toyota Station, the Fanzone and the stadium. Additional information on the shuttle bus services is available [here](#).
- Between the stadium and the park and ride car parks. Park and ride is reservation only and spaces are limited so [book](#) your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.

The location of the spectator shuttle drop-off and pick-up points at the stadium is shown on the map.

Private charter buses: There are no private bus pick-up/drop-off facilities at or near the stadium. Please do not drive to the venue unless you have made prior arrangements.



Walk

As shown on the map there are several walking routes for stadium access. Our friendly staff will be on hand to help you on your way and look out for directional signs too.



Cycle

Cycle parking is available close to the stadium as shown on the map. Please note that spaces are limited.



Park and ride

If you intend travelling by car, please use park and ride. Spaces are limited and must be reserved in advance so [book park and ride as soon as possible](#) to avoid disappointment. There are three park and ride car parks which will have direct shuttle bus services to the stadium on the day of the match. These are Kampachi Car Park, Kuragaike Park Car Park and Toyota Honsha Car Park.

There is no parking available at the venue. The only exception is for wheelchair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space beforehand (see accessible transport section). There will also be changes to how some roads operate and there are no drop-off or pick-up facilities near the stadium with the exception of taxis as shown on the map.

When planning your journey please keep in mind that roads in the area are expected to be busier than usual, particularly during regular commuting hours. Please allow plenty of time to get to the park and ride car park.



Taxi

Taxi drop-off and pick-up facilities are located close to stadium as shown on the map.



Car

There is no parking available at the venue. The only exception is for wheelchair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space beforehand (see accessible transport section). There will also be changes to how some roads operate and there are no drop-off or pick-up facilities near the stadium with the exception of taxis as shown on the map.

If you intend driving, please use park and ride (see park and ride section).



Accessible transport

Reserved parking is available for those who possess a wheelchair ticket. Assistance is available from staff to get you between the car park and the stadium. If you require additional information on travel associated with wheelchair tickets please contact the [ticket support centre](#).

Accessible shuttle buses will run between Shin-Toyota Station, the Fanzone and the Stadium. These services are for people with disabilities, wheelchair users, elderly people, pregnant women, and those who have difficulty walking.

[Additional information](#) is available separately for those with restricted mobility. It includes information on accessibility of local stations, location of toilets and other advice to assist you.

FANZONE

Getting to the Fanzone

There is a Fanzone at **Sky Hall, Toyota.**

As shown on the map, the Fanzone is an 18-minute walk from Toyota Shi Station and 20-minute walk from Shin-Toyota Station on the Aichi Loop Line. The Fanzone is also next to the spectator shuttle bus to the park and ride car parks as shown on the map.





Fanzone opening days


