GETTING TO OITA CITY

We have prepared the following advice to help you plan your travel. The hints and tips below should be read in conjunction with the information on each travel option that follows.

Plan and book ahead: Arrange your [travel](#) and [accommodation](#) as soon as possible. If you are an international visitor and intend travelling by train, we strongly recommend you purchase a [Japan Rail Pass](#) before you arrive.

Travel the right way: Roads are expected to be busy on match days so please use public transport, park and ride, walk or cycle where possible. Remember there is no parking at the venue except for wheel-chair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space. There are also no drop off or pick up facilities near the venue except for taxis. If you intended driving, please use park and ride and note it is reservation only.

Travelling from further away: Transport is expected to be busy, particularly trains before and after the match from areas such as Fukuoka, Kitakyushu and beyond. If you are travelling from further away, consider flying into Oita Airport and staying locally. We recommend looking within Oita City and elsewhere in Oita Prefecture such as Beppu City, Yufu City (Yufuin), Hita City, and Nakatsu City. [Book](#) your accommodation soon to avoid disappointment. Wherever you are travelling from please ensure you arrive early and enjoy the Oita Iko no Michi Square Fanzone and everything else the City has to offer but be

sure to leave plenty of time to get to the stadium. After the match ensure you leave enough time for any onward connections and avoid taking the last train in case of overcrowding. If you do have to queue please listen to announcements and follow directions from staff.

Travelling by car: There is no parking at or near the stadium except for those who have a wheelchair ticket and have booked parking. There are also no drop-off or pick-up facilities at the stadium except for taxis. If you intend on driving, please use park and ride. It is reservation only. Spaces are limited so [book](#) your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.

Arrive early: Arrive into Oita with enough time to soak up the atmosphere. Don't leave it too late to get to the stadium gates open three hours before kick-off. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat. There will be plenty to see and do inside so leave enough time to enjoy it, before the match starts.

Pre-paid travel cards are best: Paying for public transport is easier using a [prepaid travel card](#) or IC Card.

Pick up travel tickets in advance: Consider picking-up your travel card or other travel tickets before match-day to avoid queues at ticket machines on the day.

Head to a Fanzone: If you're in the area early on the day of the match why not visit the Fanzone at Oita Iko no Michi Square? Please check our [Fanzone](#) page for additional information.

TOP TIPS



We recommend you **arrive 90 minutes early**, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat



There will be **plenty of food, drink and entertainment** on offer in the stadium that you can enjoy. Make sure you experience the unique festival atmosphere of Rugby World Cup 2019™



Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets will be accepted, and readmission is strictly prohibited



Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card



The **following items are prohibited** from being brought into match venues: Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers etc)



It is **prohibited by law to fly drones** in and around Rugby World Cup 2019™ venues and Fanzones



Please take your rubbish with you or dispose of it at the facilities provided inside the stadium



Please note that there will be **no place to leave luggage** either inside or outside venues

GETTING TO THE STADIUM

Which travel option is best?

Find out more about each travel option here.



Air

The nearest airport is **Oita Airport** in Kunisaki. It is about 50km northeast of Oita.



Train

The nearest stations to the stadium are: **JR Oita Station** and **JR Beppu Station**.

JR Oita Station: Is about 25 minutes from the stadium via **free** shuttle bus. The shuttle bus will run between the station (south exit) and bus stops close to the stadium.

JR Beppu Station: Is about 50 minutes from the stadium via **free** shuttle bus. The shuttle bus will run between the station (west exit) and bus stops close to the stadium.

The shuttle buses are reservation only. [Spaces are limited so book your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.](#)



Bus

Spectator shuttle buses will be running on the day of the match between the stadium and several locations in the area. This includes:

- **Free** spectator shuttle buses between the stations (JR Oita and JR Beppu) and the stadium (see train section). **Spaces are limited so book your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.**
- **Free** spectator shuttle buses between the stadium and the park and ride car parks (see park and ride section). **Spaces are limited so book your place well in advance to avoid disappointment.**

See **map** for the shuttle bus drop-off and pick-up locations.

Private charter buses: There are no private bus pick-up or drop-off facilities at the stadium, but private buses will be allowed to use Tanoura park and ride car park to drop-off and pick-up (see park and ride section).



Cycle

Cycle parking is available close to the stadium as shown on the **map**



Taxi

There is a taxi drop-off and pick-up area at the stadium as shown on the **map**.



Park and ride

If you intend travelling by car, please use park and ride. Spaces are limited and must be reserved in advance so **book park and ride as soon as possible** to avoid disappointment. There are seven park and ride car parks which will have direct shuttle bus services to the stadium on the day of the match. These are at Heiwa Shimin Park, Nanasegawa Nature Park, Tsurusaki Kunimune Ground, Tanoura Car Park, Intelligent Town, Nippon Bunri University (Open only on 19 October and 20 October) and Beppu Park.

There is no parking available at the venue. The only exception is for wheelchair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space beforehand (see accessible transport section). There will also be changes to how some roads operate and there are no drop-off or pick-up facilities near the stadium with the exception of taxis as shown on the **map**.

When planning your journey please keep in mind that roads in the area are expected to be busier than usual, particularly during regular commuting hours. Please allow plenty of time to get to the park and ride car park.



Car

There is no parking available at the venue. The only exception is for wheelchair ticket holders that have reserved a parking space beforehand (see accessible transport section). There will also be changes to how some roads operate and there are no drop-off or pick-up facilities near the stadium with the exception of taxis as shown on the **map**. If you intend on driving, please use park and ride (see park and ride section).



Accessible transport

Reserved parking is available for those who possess wheelchair tickets. Assistance is available from staff to get you between the parking and the stadium. If you require additional information on travel associated with wheelchair tickets please contact the **ticket support centre**.

Additional information is available separately for those with restricted mobility. It includes information on accessibility of local stations, location of toilets and other advice to assist you.

FANZONE

Getting to the Fanzone

There is a Fanzone at **Oita Ikoi no Michi Square, Oita City.**

As shown on the map the Fanzone is a five-minute walk from Oita Station south entrance.

Fanzone highlights

With a large screen, children's rugby corner and cultural entertainment such as traditional Kagura dancing and Taiko Japanese drum show, you'll have plenty to see and do at the Fanzone.

Find dishes unique to Oita, including fish and chips made from locally sourced yellowtail and dried shiitake mushrooms, toriten and karaage fried chicken, Hita yakisoba fried noodles and plenty more at the food and drink corner

Relax and unwind with special hot spring foot baths. Oita isn't called the 'Hot Spring Prefecture' for nothing!


